

#### Total Humanitarian Arrivals 2018-19 Financial Year

Young people aged 12-24 consistently make up a significant proportion of all arrivals through Australia's Humanitarian Program. In the 2018-19 financial period, 4059 young people representing 26% of all humanitarian arrivals settled in Australia.








